

Flint Hill Elementary School Parent Falcon Five Statement of Conduct



Flint Hill Elementary School teachers and staff work with every student to learn and adhere to the Falcon 5 – **Respect, Act Safely, Follow Directions, be Prepared and Cooperate.**

As volunteers on school grounds and within each classroom, FHES administration and teachers appreciate your support in following the Falcon 5. Each year parents are asked to review the Falcon 5 with their students. This year we would like you to take a moment to review the Falcon 5 to see how it can better assist you in your volunteer activities.

1. Respect people and their property

As parent volunteer, you may have access to private information about other students in your classroom. Please do not share this information with others. Each child learns at a different pace and our teachers work hard to ensure that each student's needs are accommodated. Discussing student's private information is prohibited.

2. Act Safely

When on school grounds you must sign in and wear your printed identification badge. Be aware of your surroundings while on property and report any unusual activity to the administration immediately.

3. Follow Directions the first time given

The teachers and staff greatly appreciate the time you are giving as a volunteer. Do not hesitate to ask questions about the activity you are performing. Please do not assume or make decisions without consulting with teachers or staff.

4. Come Prepared to learn

When volunteering please come prepared to enjoy yourself and learn something new about FHES. While learning please don't be afraid to make mistakes. Elementary school is the place to learn how to make a mistake and retry again --- please help us show that to our students. Coming prepared means don't give up.

5. Cooperate with others

Communicate with the teacher or staff member so you can effectively assist with the activities. Please encourage other parents to assist in the school and engage new parents who are learning about our community.
